PROFILE

Mr Oliver graduated from Birmingham University Medical School in 1991 and became a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England (FRCS) in 1996. He trained in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Addenbrooke's Hospital Cambridge, Stoke Mandeville Hospital Aylesbury, and the Radcliffe Infirmary Oxford. He passed the Intercollegiate Specialty Examination in Plastic Surgery (FRCS Plast) in 1993. He was awarded the Ian McGregor Medal for distinction in this examination.

He then undertook a specialist fellowship in Western Australia undertaking reconstructive surgery and training in cosmetic surgery at Western Australia's Mount Hospital. On returning to the UK he was appointed as the Aesthetic

Surgical Fellow at the McIndoe Cosmetic Surgical Centre in East Grinstead. This included comprehensive training in all aspects of cosmetic surgery. He was awarded his Certificate of Completion of Specialist Training and was entered onto the General Medical Council's, (GMC), Specialist Register for Plastic Surgery in April 2005.

In June 2005 Mr Oliver was appointed as a Consultant in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery with a special interest in breast reconstruction and skin cancer surgery at the Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital with specialist clinics in Torbay and Taunton.

He has published many articles in the field of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic surgery and has presented a number of papers to the British Association of Plastic Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeons. Mr Oliver has been a full member of the British Association of Plastic Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeons (BAPRAS) since 2005.
