- Has taught the surgical aspects of implant reconstruction and augmentation of edentulous jaws to numerous dental colleagues, including Oral & Maxillo-Facial Surgeons over the past 25 years.
- Is currently submitting a paper on the Augmentation of the Maxillary Sinus & Alveolar Ridge Using Patellar Bone and the Prosthodontic Reconstruction of the Jaw.

SPECIALIST ORAL SURGERY CASES TREATED

Admitting rights are held with Harley Street Clinic and The London Clinic where oral surgical procedures are carried out under general anaesthesia .

Patients requiring local anaesthesia or sedation are operated on at the Harley Street Oral Reconstruction Centre.

Over the last 30 years , surgical referral cases have required the following treatments:

- Removal of impacted wisdom teeth and impacted teeth in general.
- Removal of ankylosed teeth.
- Apicectomies.
- Pre-prosthetic surgery.
- Removal of bone cysts and soft tissue cysts.
- Augmentation of the alveolar ridges using bone harvested from the mandible and maxilla, using both particulate grafts and block grafts.
- Sinus lift techniques, using both inlay corticocancellous block grafts and particulate grafts.
- Augmentation of the alveolar ridges using iliac crest bone, patellar bone and calvarial bone in conjunction with Maxillo-Facial Surgeons, Orthopaedic Surgeons and Plastic Surgeons who have harvested the bone.
- Placement of dental implants ranging from single implants to complete restoration of both maxilla and mandible. This has been carried out in conjunction with other Dentists who carried out the prosthodontics or who referred the patient.
- Management of the oral surgical treatment of medically compromised patients.
- Surgical treatment of trauma cases with implants.
- Placement of orbital implants following hyperbaric oxygen therapy in conjunction with Ophthalmic Surgeons and Moorfield's Eye Hospital who constructed the prostheses.

SPECIALIST PROSTHODONTIC CASES TREATED

Examples of referred cases that have been treated include:

- Occlusal rehabilitation using multiple units of crown and bridgework.
- Restoration of multiple endodontically treated teeth using sectional post cores and overlying extensive crown and bridgework.
- Restoration of worn and attrited dentition using multiple units of crown and bridgework and, where necessary, restoring vertical dimension.
- TMJ dysfunction cases using occlusal splints, followed by occlusal adjustment and reconstruction where necessary.
- Restoration of dentition using splinted crowns or bridgework with precision attachments securing removable partial dentures.
- Restoration of partial anodontia cases using combinations of implant-supported crowns and conventional crowns.
- Over-denture cases, where necessary supported by press stud attachments.
- Increased over-bite cases treated by a combination of orthodontics and crown and bridgework.
- Maxillary and mandibular fixed implant-supported full arch restorations.
- Maxillary and mandibular full arch detachable prostheses constructed on implant-supported gold bars and precision attachments.
- Partial implant-supported bridgework.
- Single tooth implant-supported restorations, either alone or as multiple units.
- Restoration of trauma cases with a combination of implant-supported and convention crown and bridgework.
