I have been an Honorary Senior Lecturer at St George's University of London and Consultant Psychiatrist since 1986. I developed specialist innovative psychiatric services for younger people with disabilities (Acute and Chronic) at St George's Hospital, London. Prior to that, I was in charge of Behavioural Unit at St Ebbas Hospital, Epsom for four years.

I developed psychiatric liaison service for Vascular Surgery, Rheumatology and Stroke Units at St George's Hospital and arrange follow up of the patients discharged from those units at their domicile. This liaison service has been highly appreciated by surgeons, physicians, patients and their families. I am actively involved in assessing patients capacity, clinical negligence and treating patients for psychological trauma after physical treatments and injuries.

For the past twenty two years I have been helping to develop community resources for people with disabilities in the London Borough of Wandsworth. I also liaise closely with GPs, social services and voluntary organizations in helping critically ill, disabled and traumatised people with their emotional problems and with ethical aspects of their treatment. My clinical work range from congenital

and acquired disabilities of all age groups excluding children. I also work with people with learning disabilities living in the Borough of Wandsworth.

My qualifications are: M.B., B.S., (1974); D.P.M (London) (1978); M.R.C.Psych. (1981); M.Phil. (London University) (1989).

I attended medical ethics and law course at King's College Hospital London.

I have written chapters and papers in journals about psychological aspects of physical disabilities. I also regularly give lectures on psychiatric aspects of disabilities.

I am an Examiner for Undergraduate Medical Students. I supervise intercalated BSc students. I teach undergraduate medical students and nurses on community aspects of care for people with congenital & acquired disabilities, liaison psychiatry, transcultural psychiatry and medico-legal aspects of disabilities.

I am a founder member of the Society of Expert Witnesses and a member of the UK Register of Expert Witnesses. I am an active member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, currently involving with financial committee.

I have been actively involved with medico-legal work for the past twenty years and have acted as Medical Referee in Tribunals and gave evidence at the Old Bailey, Royal Courts of Justice and Crown Courts.
