## Summary of clinical posts in the last twenty years

### March 1986 to December 1988

Consultant oral surgeon and head of dentistry to the **Ministry of Health, Government of Bahrain** based at Salmaniya Medical Centre with 1000 beds in the capital city of Manama. Honorary consultant oral surgeon to Bahrain Defence Force Hospital.

### January 1989 to April 1990

#### **Consultant oral surgeon and Head of Dentistry, King Khalid National Guard Hospital, Jeddah, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia**

The **KKNG** hospital provides comprehensive health care to the Saudi Arabian National Guard, their families and dependents, and to the Royal Family. It is located on the Jeddah-Makkah expressway and comprises a large residential block, Medical City, and the clinical facility with 300 beds. Most specialties are represented with the exception of plastic and neurosurgery. Liaison arrangements existed with other Jeddah hospitals for specialised investigations such as MRI scanning.

### May 1990 to July 1991

#### **Consultant oral & maxillofacial surgeon and Head of Dentistry, Government of Dubai Health & Medical Services, Dubai, United Arab Emirates**

The **consultant oral and maxillofacial surgeon** provides specialist advice and treatment for patients referred to the service. Dubai has a mixed population from many countries and **Rashid Hospital**, which has 600 beds, accepts patients for all types of health care. The **trauma unit** is based at Rashid hospital and there is also a **neurosurgical unit**. The maxillofacial service works closely with these two specialist services and a wide variety of facial trauma presents to the hospital through the on call emergency department. Cases for elective oral surgery are admitted to **Dubai Hospital** which also has 600 beds. A link has been established with the paediatric surgeons working in **Al Wasl Hospital** (400 beds), restricted to paediatrics and obstetrics, where cleft lip and palate cases receive surgery.

### July 1991 to January 1992

#### **Consultant oral and maxillofacial surgeon (locum tenens) to the Queen Victoria Hospital, East Grinstead.**

The Queen Victoria Hospital is a specialised referral centre for oral and maxillofacial surgery, plastic surgery and corneoplastic surgery serving a wide area including several district hospitals. The hospital was originally established to cater for severely burned airmen

in the Second World War and contains the McIndoe Burns Unit. At the same time, many patients with facial injuries were also treated. The maxillofacial service has been developed as the range of the specialty has expanded and now includes surgery for facial deformity, oncology including reconstructive and microvascular surgery, together with the treatment of facial trauma using mini and micro bone plates which have revolutionised the immobilisation and fixation of fractures of the facial skeleton. Surgery to the soft tissues includes cleft lip and palate repair, and autogenous bone grafting of alveolar clefts. There is a very active division of orthodontics and patients requiring orthognathic surgery are jointly assessed and treated. Fixed appliance therapy often precedes mandibular or maxillary osteotomies which are sometimes combined in bimaxillary surgery.

### **February 1992 to July 1992**

#### **Consultant oral and maxillofacial surgeon (locum tenens) to Sunderland District General Hospital.**

This hospital is a sub-regional referral centre for the north East of England and has close links with the teaching hospital in Newcastle upon Tyne. One of the consultants with whom I worked, Professor Ward-Booth, has now joined Queen Victoria Hospital and the clinical practice at the two centres is very similar with a very wide range of work and excellent supporting staff.

### **July 1992 to April 1998**

#### **Consultant oral & maxillofacial surgeon (substantive) to the North Glamorgan NHS Trust and honorary visiting consultant to the University Hospital of Wales, Cardiff, and honorary clinical teacher to the University of Wales School of Medicine.**

The Maxillofacial Directorate of the North Glamorgan NHS Trust provides a wide range of clinical services within the region including the Prince Charles Hospital, Merthyr Tydfil, the East Glamorgan Hospital, Pontypridd, the Princess of Wales Hospital, Bridgend and Bridgend General Hospital. The oral and maxillofacial service is provided by three consultant surgeons and two consultant orthodontists, supported by a senior registrar, two associate specialists, four senior house officers and two house officers. There is also a Special Needs service, and a dental laboratory located within East Glamorgan Hospital. The unit also contains nursing and secretarial staff including three nursing sisters.

The surgical service provides a full range of treatment for patients referred by other specialties, general medical and general dental practitioners. Treatment including consultation and diagnosis is available both as an out-patient and in-patient service. All general conditions and diseases of the face and jaws are accepted including oral pathology, dentoalveolar surgery, traumatic injuries, orthognathic surgery and orofacial cancer. Close liaison exists with related specialties and there is access to intensive care units in Bridgend and Merthyr Tydfil.

There is an active post-graduate department and regular presentations and lectures are given by all levels of staff. There is an exchange programme with the USA. There are close links

with the University Hospital of Wales Dental Hospital and consultants from the unit provide clinical teaching for the undergraduates. Members of the department are regular attendees of national and international meetings. Postgraduate courses are held for MGDS post-graduates, vocational training and nursing staff.

Future developments include a transfer of the clinical facilities at East Glamorgan Hospital to the Royal Glamorgan Hospital, a new district general hospital nearing completion at Llantrisant, in 1999. The consultants have been very active within the management structure of the hospitals within the Directorate. The Princess of Wales Hospital became a Trust Hospital in April 1993.

### **May 1998 to present date**

#### **Independent consultant maxillofacial surgeon at the Princess Grace Hospital and the Harley Street Clinic**

In 1998, I established an independent surgical consulting practice and medicolegal service based in Wiltshire and London. The practice office is located in a modern apartment in Old Swindon (telephone 0845 130 1370). The clinical practice operates from the The Harley Street Clinic, London and the Princess Grace Hospital. Contract services are provided to NHS maxillofacial units throughout Britain. Included in these is Raigmore Hospital, Inverness, serving a catchment area the size of Belgium.

I have established The Cavendish Chambers Limited to bring together medical experts and instructing lawyers.
